Once you have accepted or been placed, please contact your Host Company to arrange housing and other aspects of the arrival process. Your official start date will be scheduled once you arrive at the employer. Start dates may vary several days from your DS date. Please be patient and allow the employer to integrate you into the schedule.

Additional position information: WHAT TO EXPECT AT WORK: This position is very physically demanding. You will be bending, lifting, twisting, pushing, and pulling over 50 lbs. You will be working on the beach for the majority of your shifts and going back and forth from the warehouse. You will be setting up and breaking down all rental chairs and umbrellas every day and you will have a split schedule.

> MEDICAL ISSUES: If you travel to the U.S. knowing that you have a medical condition that would prevent you from working at your pre-arranged job,


