Arrival Instructions: Upon arrival, go directly to housing to rest and unpack. Arrive to the employer Monday-Thursday, 9am-7pm and report to the manager on duty. The first 1-2 weeks your hours are not guaranteed. Your hours will be based on training, your work performance and attendance.
